Mr. Fournier requested and received permission to audio tape the hearing.

Deputy-Mayor Plato called the hearing to order at 11:00 a.m.

Chief Administrative Officer Johnson provided Councillor Lodge's regrets however noted he wanted Council to be aware that he agrees that the 2010 Financial Plan be approved as presented.

Councillor Campbell agreed that the financial plan be approved as presented which includes cost-share ventures approved at a previous joint meeting with the Rural Municipality of Lac du Bonnet however had grave concern on the amount being paid to the Lions Club of Lac du Bonnet for Fireworks. This is due to the article which appeared in the Leader today identifying that the Lions are donating monies (\$15,000.00) towards an Ambulance Bay upgrade which we were assured by the North Eastman Health Association on May 28, 2009, would be completed by the North Eastman Health Association Provincially. Councillor Campbell is of the opinion if they can afford to be donating community funds towards a Provincial requirement that the Town residents should not be donating to them to funnel donations. To be further discussed at the 2011 joint cost share meeting with the Rural Municipality of Lac du Bonnet and the initial 2011 Financial Plan/Budget meeting for our Town.

Chief Administrative Officer Johnson and Office Clerk Kjartanson provided a verbal presentation on hi lights to the 2010 Financial Plan as well as answered inquiries or provided contact information to the gallery.

At this time second and third readings were given to the 2010 Financial Plan/Budget By-Law No. 106/10. Resolutions 105/10 and 106/10

It was noted that By-Law 42/04 will be re-named "Medical and/or Personal Care Facility Reserve" as noted on the 2010 Financial Plan. At this time Council proceeded to give By-Law No. 107/10 first and second readings. Resolutions 107/10 and 108/10




